



Active lunch break on Thursday (3.09.2020) at 11:30 am!

DW's measly proposition of salary and fee increases at only 1% has outraged many colleagues. And rightly so! Because:

- Corona is a disease and not a DW austerity program!
- DW's budget has risen by 30% since 2014, because of our good work!
- Germany's public sector - with which we should always compare ourselves - concluded its last round of collective bargaining with a volume of 8%. And, for the next round, next year, the unions are demanding 4.8 percent.

We too deserve more!

DW maintains that this is not possible, ostensibly because of Corona. Why?

Remember: during the latest round of collective bargaining, all German public broadcasters (with the exception of DW) have already conceded to their employees significantly higher settlements. Here are a few examples:

BR 2.4% für 2020, 3.21% für 2021
Deutschlandradio: 2.25% for 2020, 2.25% for 2021
MDR: 2.3% for 2019, 2.2% for 2020
WDR: 2.25% for 2020, 2.25% for 2021
ZDF 4.0% for 2020, 2.75% for 2021

These are decent tariff increases – even though, economically, these stations are now having to adjust painfully to tightly calculated public broadcast fees.

At DW the money is there! Austerity plans by parliament, DW's funding body, are not evident.

Let's show the DW our indignation...
